Our new prosecco is made by Tallero from grapes grown on the hills of the Treviso region of North Eastern, Italy. The vines are predominantly Glera grown in a mild and diverse territory. The alluvial soil is mainly clay with an abundance of mineral content providing the perfect terrain. We also ship a prosecco from one of our favourite growers north of Udine in Friuli. Finally we have stocks of Ciroto's Extra Brut "skinny" prosecco with a very low sugar content more like champagne!

### RED



We import Château Plaisance from the region of Frontonnais near Toulouse where the main grape varieties used are unusual. The wines have to contain a minimum of 50% Negrette, an unusual variety particular to the vineyards of Toulouse, the rest of the blend is made up by either of the two Cabernets, Gamay, Syrah and Cot or Merille. Thus giving the wine its typicity; a very dark colour, a complex nose of crushed black fruits and a full bodied, characterful, and fruity palate. Very good value and delicious, also available in magnums. We have added Alabets 100% Negrette to the range and the top of the range Tot Co Que Cal an amazing dense and powerful wine.

## SOUTHERN RHÔNE



This region starts about fifty kilometres south of Valence and extends as far as Montelimar to the south. The most famous wine from this region is Châteauneuf-du-Pape. We import the superb wines from *Château la Canorgue* in the Luberon and a new addition is the wine from Pasquiers. The rich Plan de Dieu comes from limestone blue-clay soil covered in pebbles. It is 65% Grenache, 25% Syrah, and 5% Carignan, 5% Cinsault and ages 12 months after malolactic. Sablet is from 40year old vines on limestone clay soil on the slopes and is 60% Grenache, 30% Syrah and 10% Mourvedre. Vinification for both is by variety with 15 days maceration and blending is after tasting. The small Gigondas 1.10ha vineyard is 50% Grenache 50% Syrah, fermented together with a 24 day maceration and 9 months ageing in tank
